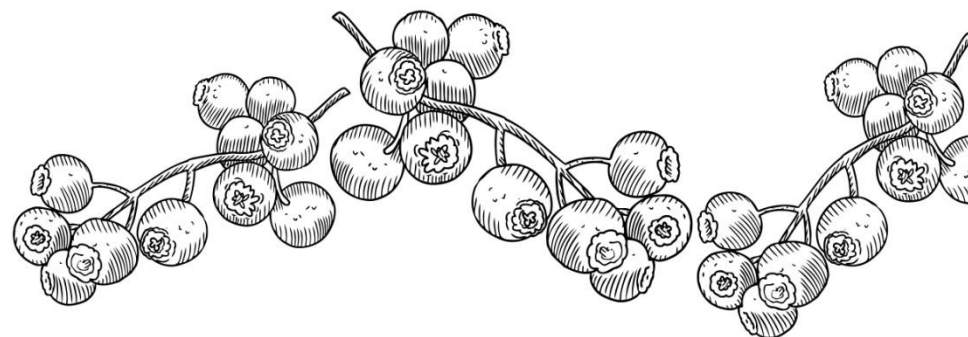

Within a few years of Thornbury Orchestra forming it outgrew a lot of the venues in Thornbury. It was realised that there was a need for a smaller orchestra to be able to bring performances into those spaces. Thornbury Chamber Players (TCP) was formed to fill that gap and has been playing for 10 years. It also provides the basis for Little Projects when instrumentalists are needed to accompany choral pieces or as in the case last year to work with international soloists.

As well as local venues, TCP has performed for the Dursley Coffee Concert series, in the beautiful Framilode Church, to accompany the Refugee Aid Choir in Stroud and in St Mary's, Wotton under Edge.
